- no herbicides or pesticides, unless certified organic

Be Considerate

- put hoses and tools back in their original places, respect neighbouring plots, keep plots weed free

Compost Responsibly

- use compost bins as the signage indicates

No Invasive Plants

- such as mint, Jerusalem artichoke, etc.

Follow Greenhouse Protocol

- Guidelines for types of plants, watering & ventilation

Contribute to Communal Work Regularly

- Workbees as a group or individual tasks (Min 4 hours)

Keep Pets on A Leash & Clean Up After

The 2022 membership fee is \$20.00 and fees are due at the first communal workbee/information session. We will also allocate beds and greenhouse spaces at this time. (Date: TBA)
